

Montana State Law Immune Requirements 2016/2017

6th grade:

- 5 - DPT, DTaP, Dt, or Td (4 doses if 4th dose given on or after 4th birthday)
- 4 - Polio - (3 doses if 3rd dose given on or after 4th birthday)
- 2 - MMR - given on or after 1st birthday
- 2 - Varicella (chickenpox) 2 doses as of October 1, 2015

7th and 8th grade:

- 5 - DPT, DTaP, Dt, or Td (4 doses if 4th dose given on or after 4th birthday)
- 4 - Polio - (3 doses if 3rd dose given on or after 4th birthday)
- 2 - MMR - given on or after 1st birthday
- 1 - Tdap (prior to entering 7th grade)
- 2 - Varicella (chickenpox) 2 doses as of October 1, 2015

DTP = Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis
DTaP = Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis
Dt = Diphtheria, Tetanus
Td = Tetanus, Diphtheria
Tdap = Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis
MMR = Measles, Mumps, Rubella

Please send or fax documentation showing the receipt of these immunizations to the school at any time. Immunizations are available at your family physician or at the Lewis and Clark Health Department (443-2584). The Health Department's Immunization Clinic is held each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 11 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and is located at 1930 - 9th Avenue.

If you have questions regarding the information on your student's school immunization record, you may call the Helena Middle School office at 324-1000. The school office is open from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. in the summer and 7:30 am - 4 p.m. during the school year.
